

Four Lane Blacktop Ways of Working/Things that will be Different

We have taken steps to reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission while on club premises, as outlined in the plan published by the club. Whilst every effort has been made to ensure the plan meets the government guidelines, all individuals attending a FLBT event should also refer to the latest advice contained on the www.gov.uk website.

By coming to the premises you confirm you have read, understood and agree to the contents of the Four Lane Blacktop COVID Plan, Four Lane Blacktop Ways of Working document as well as current government advice.

Things will be different. Here is a reminder of the major changes. For full details please see the Plan published by the club.

1. Let us know that you are coming, using the FLBT Members Group or other message. Numbers will be limited to allow social distancing. If you have tested positive for COVID-19, or have knowingly come into contact with someone who has tested positive in the last 14 days, or feel unwell in any way, do not come to the club. If you test positive after attending the club, you must let us know.
2. Bring and wear Face Coverings: use the disposable gloves and/or the hand sanitiser provided
3. Maintain 1m+ social distance at all times.
4. Bring the minimum kit possible: Two cars, one controller and spares plus tools, in a backpack, bag for life or small toolbox.
5. Wipe down communal surfaces before and after use with the provided disinfectant.
6. The kitchen is off limits, bring personal drinks if required.
7. Follow the one-way system in the room at all times.
8. Practice will be organised, with pre-race practice of four laps before each race.
9. Please stay at your designated marshalling point/driver station after racing until asked to move by the race controller.

Additional, set-up crew and taking down the track:

1. Pin hall doors open
2. Open back door and windows if not raining
3. No more than two people in the store room
4. Set out driver stations, designated marshal points and race control and parc ferme/pit table if required to allow 1m+ social distancing
